08/05/09 Thursday

Buttiful warm summer day. Slightly overcast with light showers tonight. Got a letter from my Sammy today, gee, but didn't it seem queer not to have my own little girl with me. Paid C. E. French \$75 Died Lidie Dean

08/06/09 Friday

Buttiful warm summer day. Youngtown School had their annual picnic at Crehore Grove mit a ball game. Roy and I went up a little while. I wrote to my small Sammy girl today. Hope she is OK.

08/07/09 Saturday

Fair and very warm. Came up home early got Sammy and we went up to Seller Pond and we painted my boat. Sammy's mother sick so she not come home mit me. Note to R. Fernald for \$75 due today. Paid August 5, 1909.

08/08/09 Sunday

Terrible hot day just awful. Sammy and I went up to Seller Pond. Boat leak like a sive. Sink her swim ashore. Big shower came up drive down to Smike's, put team in barn, rain like helly.

08/09/09 Monday

Another hot old day. With several brisk showers. Drove down and see Sammy a little while this morning. My Sammy how I wish we were together all of the time.

08/10/09 Tuesday

Fair mixed with showers. Thear has been several today. Went to Camden with Emery tonight. A crowd of six pusson's stopped here tonight and I stopped up at Phoebe's. Yow. Wouldn't Sammy be mad.

08/11/09 Wednesday

Buttiful clear and cold but Sammy has just played me a mean old trick. No letter came and that's what makes me mad.

08/12/09 Thursday

Just one clear cool buttifful day, fine. Got a letter from my small girl Sammy and I am afraid she is some down on her luck, somehow.

08/13/09 Friday

Just a nice kind of a day. Wrote to my Sammy Kinney and will be with her tomorrow at this time. She is such a good girl. Died Henry Duncan (Old Shackle Shanks)

08/14/09 Saturday

Fair and some cooler. Went up and got Sammy and we went up to the Seller Pond. I got my boat up and bailed out, had it sunk for the past week. Sammy came over home with me.

08/15/09 Sunday

Fine clear coolish day. Sam Perry came today. Deedee and I went trouting down the stream got 7. Sammy and I went up to Seller Pond tonight got 10 big white perch.

08/16/09 Monday

Fair and cool it has been partly overcast all day. Fire started on the Trap Mt. this afternoon. No damage. Sam and Edith went home today.

08/17/09 Tuesday

Overcast this morning. Commenced to rain about noon and didn't it just come down in bunches. Grange picknick. No dance [inserted - Died Mirah Dean aged 65] on account of rain. Went out to see Sammy and by gar that girl been brave, went have aching tooth out. She much brave girlie.

08/18/09 Wednesday

Did it rain today. Well one would not have to ask if they could just feel the seat of my pants. It just simply poured. Wrote my Sambo Jonsing a letter.

08/19/09 Thursday

Fair all clear away fine. But it is just a very little muddy sos to speak. Mrs. Dean buried today. Got a letter from my Sambo Jonson.

08/20/09 Friday

Buttifful day clear and rather warm. Carlo Don Pedro Rankin shook a quart of Manhattan Club cocktails at me today and what could a poor boy do. I did it anyway. I wrote my Sammy.

08/21/09 Saturday

Fair nice day, went up and got my Sammy tonight and she went over home with me and we just had the mostest fun tonight.

08/22/09 Sunday

Buttifful warm summer day. Sammy and I went over to her house early this morning. Hump and his fambily came down. Smike and I runned away down to the Ctr, Play Ball.

08/23/09 Monday

Fair and darned warm. Ye hot as L or hotter. Roy Hurd got his new AJ Aubrey shotgun from Sears Roebuck this morning. She's a beauty, 28" barrel, 10 gage. Sammy had a gold crown put on one of her teeth today.

08/24/09 Tuesday

And this has been a fine yallar kind of a day. Wrote my small Sammy this morning. She had a gold cap put on one of her ?? teeth, fine job. Killed in New York on tugboat "Bee" George Drinkwater. Boiler exploded.

08/25/09 Wednesday

Hot hottest and hotter terrible and this is the anual picnic day. I drove over this afternoon. Biggest crowd ever. Ball Game at the Ctr, East Union via Lin EU won 3-1. Dance Ctr tonight, Sammy and I went.

08/26/09 Thursday

Overcast, heavy shower this afternoon. Just a trifle warm today. But not as bad as it was last night and yesterday. The Disneys went away this morning. Ise so tired and so awfull sleepy. Ormand Law and all his people went to their new home in Providence.

08/27/09 Friday

Buttiful clear and cold with a brisk west wind. Nothing doing. Took gun and went out a little while tonight. No luck. Tomorrow night I am hoping I shall be out in God's country. Had Tim shod. \$1.

08/28/09 Saturday

Fair nice day, drove up and got Sammy tonight. She is not feeling very well but she went over home with me just same. Father and Mother gone to Camden.

08/29/09 Sunday

This has been a regular mixed day. Now you have and now you don't. Showers and sunshine. Sammy and I went on a ride up to the Seller Pond and down to Hump's.

08/30/09 Monday

One of the most perfect days of the year. Buttiful "great fine good." Carried Sammy home this morning and I have another SB of a tooth aching. DAMN IT Paid Mrs. French in full to date \$20.

08/31/09 Tuesday

Another buttiful clear cool day. Powerful cold last night. Heavy frost froze the crops and raised the devil even froze ice. Father hauled me a load of hay. Put it in Em's stable. Wrote to Sammy. 1380 lb of hay at \$18 per ton equals \$12.42. Roscoe Hurd.
