### ***09/02/10 Friday***

Another fione day. Big Democratic Rally at Ctr. Ex-gov. Folk of "MO" spoke. Allso Cyrus W. Davis of Waterville, ME and this evening John Brown of Surry spoke on Socilisam. Sammy and I took in the whole thing.

### ***09/03/10 Saturday***

Overcast but still a nice cool day. Went up home this afternoon and took my double end boat down to the Coleman Pond. Rain this evening but I went over and got Sammy tonight. Bag oats \$1.50.

### ***09/04/10 Sunday***

Overcast and thick fog this morning. I got up[ early 4:30 and went down to the pond. Took my gun, see a fox below AI Young. Fored at him. No Luck. Fine shot. Caught 3 nice pirsch and a big pickereal. Drown . Geo. Pendleton. Age 34. Fell from row boat in N.Y. Drunk.

### ***09/05/10 Monday***

Foggy but a fine calm day. Sammy, Dede and I went fishing at Coleman Pond.. We got 22 w. Pirsch and Sammy caught a big pickerel and a gold fish about 8 inches never see any thing like it before. This is Labor Day so I don't have to drive.

### ***09/06/10 Tuesday***

Still foggy and has raned about all day. Carried Sammy home this morning then came back to work again./ School commenced today Dede is going. I see her this noon . up at the Tucker Schoolhouse.

### ***09/07/10 Wednesday***

Slightly overcast fog. Came out home tonight. Stoped at Coleman Pond fished awhile. Sammy and I went to the Ctr. Socilest lecture by Rev. Clinton Simonton of Arkansa. Fine speaker. Paid Covel in full for grane. \$16.90 Paid H.C. Thomas in full. \$12.00.

### ***09/08/10 Thursday***

Still some fog. Went out to the pond again tonight. Allso, to the Ctr. The Rev. Simon-ton spoke on the merits of Socisiam at the Old Church. Fine lecture. Sammy went with me. Miss Foster one of our town's women started today for a visit in China. Bag corn \$1.55 Bag oats \$1.40.

### ***09/09/10 Friday***

Heavy fog rain this morning and a big shower this afternoon. Em'ry is so he can sit up now. 12 weeks yesterday since he cut his leg. Went to bed this afternoon and had a nap, first time I have slept in about a week. Born to Miller Ross and wife a 10 and a

half pound son. Hugh Jackson.

### ***09/10/10 Saturday***

Another fine day . Went out to Goodwins tonight had tire welded and set. Shaft iron mended then went up to Benson Noyse and got Sammy. She has been working there . Then she came over home with me. Bag oats \$1.40 First frost tonight.

### ***09/11/10 Sunday***

Butifull day fair and cool. Sammy and I went on a long ride out through Belmont "Tunk Wood". Nice time. Jaded a sliver under my fingernale tonight gad but it is sore.

### ***09/12/10 Monday***

Fog this morning but cleared away early.. Butifull day. Carried Sammy home. This is election day. I stoped and voted and voted the Socilest Ticket. Democrats electid gov. Plasted by 9000 magority first time in 30 years. Socilest vote in this time 33 straight 2 split a gain of 9 in two years. Paid Mrs. F. in full to date \$10.00.

### ***09/13/10 Tuesday***

Nice day fair and cool. Geo. Pendleton's body brought home from NY and buried. Returns from election shows the Democrats carried about everything in the state and electid a US Senitor first time in 50 years. Wrote Sammy a letter.

### ***09/14/10 Wednesday***

Rain like the devil all last night. Wrote Sammy a letter. Cleared away and has been a fine day. Democrats swept everything in the state. 21 senater and 88 in the house. ### ***09/16/10 Friday***

Butifull day fair and cool. Em'ry went out doors on his own legs first time in 12 weeks. I don't know what the trouble is but I am feeling rotten. Must be on account of the big democratic victory. And I didnt get any letter from Sammy eather. Paid C. A. Stevens \$25.00.

### ***09/17/10 Saturday***

Overcast. Came up home took my old 10 boar gun and went out looking for birds. I looked that's all the good it did. Went down and got Sammy tonight. Raining a little this evening.

### ***09/18/10 Sunday***

Butifull day fair and very warm. Sammy and I went down to her house, then drove down to the pond. We went over to the Soap Stone Quarry on Loon Island. First time Sammy was ever there. I carved a picture of the Old Meeting House on a hunk of soapstone tonight.

### ***09/19/10 Monday***

Overcast. Showers and a miserable cold raw day. Carried my Sammy home this morning. This afternoon have been building the model for Will's shoe soleing machine over at Orren Ames.

### ***09/20/10 Tuesday***

Butifull day clear and calm. Got a letter from Sammy. She went up to Benson's this morning. Worked on Will's model this afternoon for awhile and then went over to the Island with Orren Ames and his powerboat, first time, then Guss Gardner had a shock.

### ***09/21/10 Wednesday***

Another butiful day. Went over to Ames shop this afternoon and worked on the model. Wrote Sammy a letter. And this is the day Leslie C. Dean is tried for stealing Fifteen Thousand Dollars worth of bonds from his Aunt Mariah after her death.

### ***09/22/10 Thursday***

Butifull day clear fair and cool. Went out got Sammy and tonight we went up to Cillely's Hall to a dance and had a fine time. 25 couple. Frank Pendleton and Clarence Hurd played on violins, Oscar Gould the paino, The L. C. Dean bond case decided against Dean. Bag corn \$1.50 Bag oats \$1.40.

### ***09/25/10 Sunday***

This has been a nice day warm, but slightly overcast. Just took a good long sleep today rested. Geo. Thomas Jackson was here for awhile tonight. Sammy and I have just lofed the day away.

### ***09/26/10 Monday***

Rain hard last night, but it has been a butifull day. Carried my Sammy home this morning. This afternoon did some work on the patent. Tonight Orren Ames, Sidney Pendleton and myself appraised the Otes Heal estate at \$600.00. \$1760.00 in the Camden Bank making \$2360.00 in all. Died Guss Gardner.

### ***09/27/10 Tuesday***

Butifull Day. Town Fair. Did not go but went to the dance tonight. Keyes Orchestry of Belfast was billed to play but Keyes got on a spree and could not be found, so the management got Prof. Brown. Had a fine time about 125 couples. The Grange made \$104.43 cost me \$1.25 Bag corn \$1.50 Bag oats \$1.40 Had Tim shod now owe \$7.12.

### ***09/28/10 Wednesday***

Rain this morning hard. Cleared away early and has been a butifull day. Went out to Goodwin's this afternoon got Molly shod \$1.00 paid. Em'ry broke ground today for

the new mill and I am feeling bum, no sleep and a rotten cold.

***09/29/10 Thursday***

This has been another fine day clear and cool. Wrote my Sammy a letter but did not get one. Expected it too. Went over to Orren's shop and fixed Ren Mathews wheel. Died Willard Calderwood's youngest boy age 3 ½ years. Bag oats \$1.40.

***09/30/10 Friday***

Fair fine butifull day. Got a letter from my Sammy. She is working for Bessie Harvy, dressmaking. Just wish I was out home with her tonight. Probily it will storm tomorrow. Wind sounds like it tonight. Oh you Sammy Jonsin.
