09/04/11 Monday

Buttiful day, "Labor Day" also vacation day. Don't have to drive. Percy Cross, Hans Rankin, Smike McKinney and I went plesuring. Coleman Pond. Had a swell dinner of fried fish, boiled potatoes, rost corn and strong coffee. Got 21 big white pirsch and two big bullheads. Guys day out.

09/05/11 Tuesday

Clear and very warm, nice day. Came up to Sammy's and tonight we went to the Ctr to hear the Rev. Clinton Simonton lecture on Socilism at the Old Church. Great speaker. Smike and I went down to the Medow Stream and got two pickerel and got wet.

09/06/11 Wednesday

Rain hard this forenoon, buttiful clear and cool tonight. Came up to Sammy's and we went to the play "Down by the Sea" given by the Gale Fambily of Hope. Dance afterwards, good play like hell it was but a fine time at the dance.

09/07/11 Thursday

Buttiful day, nice one, stoped down at the Beach tonight. Mother and Abbie went to Camden and left Archie here with Mrs. French and he raised the very devil. Gladys French Bullock went away today.

09/08/11 Friday

Buttiful day fair clear and cool. Paid Mrs. French in full today \$10. Came up to Sammy's this afternoon was going fishing with Smike but he had already gone with Percy Cross so I spent the evening and trimmed him playing checkers.

09/09/11 Saturday

Fogg rain like two hells this afternoon. Came up to Sammy's put my hourse in Josh's stable and stoped all night. "Herbert" "Smike" "Grogan" and two of his daughters went back to Newton tonight. Parker Young carried them away.

09/10/11 Sunday

Buttiful clear day. Sammy and I went down to Co Pond this afternoon, took George Mahoney's boat, caught two fine white pirsch and picked two quarts of nice cranberries.

We didn't get home until long after dark. Came down to the Beech tonight.

09/13/11 Monday

Buttiful day also voting day for the question is before the people whether Proibition shall remain on the statute books or not.. Came up to Sammy's tonight and we went to a sociliest lecture at the Town House by Simenton.

09/12/11 Tuesday

Rain like hell this morning but cleared away fine afternoon. Came up to Sammy's and we went fishing "Coleman Pond" nothing doing so Sammy went over home with me tonight. Bought me a new alarm clock \$1.

09/13/11 Wednesday

Buttiful day clear and cool. Powerfull cold tonight stoped down to the Elmwood [MRS. FRENCH'S?] tonight. Prof. Brown went away for the winter. Covel sold his house the "Hillcrest" [ONE OF THE BEACH ROAD HOUSES] to Greenwoods.

09/14/11 Thursday

Cold as the devil. Came up to Sammy's got her and tonight we went out to East Searsmont to the Marriner schoolhouse to hear Simenton lecture on socilison. Big time. Mrs. French left today for a visit in Kentville Nova Scotia. Bag ground oats \$1.30 bag corn \$1.60.

09/15/11 Friday

Cold overcast, raining hard tonight. Ray Coombs shot two duck in Pitcher Pond. Got my new Ithaca gun today, 12 gauge 26 inch barrel..right cylinde left full choke weight 6 ¾ pounds. Twist barrel, four inch drop to the 14 inch stock Buty.

09/16/11 Saturday

Rain most all day. Came up got my Sammy, she went over home with me. Mrs. Fanny West a friend of mother's came up home with me this afternoon for a little viset.

09/17/11 Sunday

Thick fogg, rain. Took Tim this morning went down to Camp Rabbit shot two partridge and got five nice big black ducks, seven birds at twelve shots.

09/18/11 Monday

Overcast bum old day. Came up got Sammy and tonight we had a fine game supper. Percy Cross was invited and this evening he, Sammy and I rode down to the Town House to hear Clinton Simenton lecture on Socilisam.

09/19/11 Tuesday

Overcast and rain most all day. Emry, Jack Law and I went out to Camp Rabbit after ducks. Nothing doing. I fired at one piddy but missed. Stoped down tonight. Bag ground oats \$1.30.

09/20/11 Wednesday

Buttiful day fair and warm. Came out home tonight, put ten courses of shingles on roof of the barn anax. Went over to Sammy's and we played checkers and I got trimed. Bag

oats \$1.55

09/21/11 Thursday

Another fine day. Stopped down tonight. Went gunning this afternoon but never fired a shot. Tonight have been doing a Socialist lecture bill to tack up on the Town House. Died Alton Dean.

09/22/11 Friday

Fair buttiful day. Came up to Sammy's tonight. We printid some bills announcing Simonton's Socialist at the Town House next Monday night. Bag corn \$1.60 Father took Tim down to Goodwins and got him shod new \$1 not paid.

09/25/11 Monday

Fairly good day till afternoon then commenced to rain. Went out home this afternoon have been doing shingling on the new addition. Died Hollis French suicide. Bag oats \$1.55

09/26/11 Tuesday

Cold as hell or colder. Came up home tonight worked on the new barn. Raining like the devil tonight. Would like to see Sammy. Bag corn \$1.60

09/27/11 Wednesday

Another pretty fair kind of a day until night then it just let in and has rained like hell. Came up home tonight brought four windows for the barn \$2.90.

09/28/11 Thursday

Very cold. Came up home this afternoon and have been hard at work shingling on the barn. Went over to Sammy's tonight and now I wish I hadn't because we quarried something firce.

09/29/11 Friday

Very cold miserable bitch of a day. Was glad to get into my fur coat. Raining like the very devil this afternoon. Simonton was to speak at the Town House tonight but am afraid this rain will spoil it all.

09/30/11 Saturday

Nice day. Came up to Sammy's this afternoon stoped and gunned along the road but nothing doing. Sammy came over with me tonight. We went to the Town House first and listened to a powerfull Socialist lecture by one Clinton Simonton.
